Program Descriptions

Early Childhood: Please join one of our very own Early Childhood teachers, Milana Norbut, for a magical summer experience designed just for little ones. The children will enjoy a holistic morning rhythm that will include circle, story, and a natural craft activity. They will share a nutritious snack and spend time exploring Volunteer Park. **The half-day program is suitable for ages 3-6 and is appropriate for those not yet eligible for first grade enrollment in the Fall of 2019. Camp will run from 9am-12:30 pm. Camp minimum is 5 students, maximum is 8 students.**

Grades: Come join us this summer for more learning and creativity! Ms. Kruell will be working with incoming **1st-3rd graders** to solidify reading and math skills needed for the younger grades in a Waldorf setting. The daily rhythm of our camp will be similar to the rhythm that is held during the school year: a longer, more focused block of work in the morning, with art and outdoor play in the afternoon. Each week campers will hear stories and participate in circle activities, games, painting, drawing, and outdoor play. Reading and pre-reading skills will be practiced during weeks of language arts weeks, while number sense and math skills will be used during the designated math weeks. Each week will be different, even if we are practicing the same skills, so come for one or all four weeks! **Camp will run from 9am-12:30pm for the half-day program and 9am-3pm for the full-day program. Camp minimum is 8 students, maximum is 12 students.**

Consent and Liability Waiver

I hereby give permission for my student to participate in Bright Water Waldorf School field trips during the 2019 summer program. I understand field trips may require transportation to a location away from the school campus.

As a parent or guardian, I understand that the school and staff will try to prevent accidents.

However, I fully understand that some activities on field trips involve inherent risks to students regardless of all feasible safety measures that may be taken by the school. In consideration of the school's agreement to allow my child to participate in the referenced field trip, I agree to accept responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to my child that occurs during my child's participation in this field trip that is not the result of fraud, willful injury to a person or property, or the willful or negligent violation of the law by a trustee, employee, or agent of Bright Water Waldorf School.

In the event it becomes necessary for school staff in charge to obtain emergency care for my child, neither he/she for the school assumes financial liability for expenses incurred because of an accident, injury, illness and/or unforeseen circumstances. I authorize Bright Water Waldorf

School employees or volunteers in charge of the students to obtain all necessary emergency medical care and authorize any licensed physician and/or medical personnel to render necessary emergency treatment for my child.

Terms & Conditions of Enrollment

I agree to pay the non-refundable tuition deposit. Such amounts will not be refunded under any circumstance.

I understand that enrollment or admission of a student for the summer does not constitute an agreement for continued enrollment for future years. Re-enrollment offers are at the discretion of the school, with no right of renewal.

All parents, guardians, or other persons responsible for payments should read all the provisions of this contract, complete the required information, and sign and return the contract to Bright Water Waldorf School accompanied by the required payments as described below.

A student is enrolled or re-enrolled for the term set forth above when the contract has been delivered to Bright Water Waldorf School, signed, dated, and with the non-refundable tuition deposit.

Tuition Liability

I agree to pay tuition and fees to Bright Water Waldorf School for the named student in the amount stated above.

I understand and agree that:

The student's right to attend camp is dependent on me making all payments as scheduled.

I understand and acknowledge that it would be disruptive and detrimental to Bright Water Waldorf School if my student is withdrawn or dismissed after enrollment, even if the school is eventually able to fill the vacancy left by my student's withdrawal or dismissal. I understand and agree that once my student is enrolled, if enrollment is terminated by me or the school, I shall continue to be liable for tuition for the full term of this Agreement, according to the following schedule:

Withdraw before/Percentage of Tuition Liability:

Before June 1st, 2019; 100% minus deposit

After June 1st, 2019; No refunds

Policies and dismissal/suspension

I understand and shall abide by the policies and procedures as set forth in the Bright Water Waldorf School Parent Handbook, including the Parent Code of Conduct. I consent to participation in and compliance with those actions by Bright Water Waldorf School undertaken to comply with health and safety regulations. Bright Water Waldorf School's policies and procedures are subject to change; I agree that it is my responsibility to stay informed.

Bright Water Waldorf School reserves the right to deny enrollment to, or to dismiss or suspend a student in its sole and absolute discretion. Such dismissal or suspension may occur for reasons including, but not limited to, behavior as described in the Student Code of Conduct and Parent Handbook, illegal activity, actions that disrupt the educational environment, violations of school policies, or for non-payment of any financial agreements. Bright Water Waldorf School may dismiss or deny enrollment to any student who, in the sole judgment of the administration of the school, or has engaged in conduct which is detrimental to the school or otherwise contrary to its mission or values. If, in the sole judgment of the administration of the school, a parent(s)/guardian(s) is/are engaged in conduct which is not consistent with a positive and constructive relationship between the school and the family, or is otherwise detrimental to the school or contrary to its mission or values this could also serve as grounds for denying enrollment.

Limitations on Access.

I understand and agree that Bright Water Waldorf School reserves the right to set reasonable conditions for access to the school for parents and students. I consent to and am aware that Bright Water Waldorf School has no obligation or authority to enforce custody or parent visitation issues, but that documentation of any restrictions of parental access or rights imposed by a court must be provided to the school so that authorities can be notified in the event of a violation. I agree to provide any such court order and such necessary supporting documents as Bright Water Waldorf School may require. Bright Water Waldorf School reserves the right to contact the appropriate authorities should disputes of this type arise. I acknowledge and agree that Bright Water Waldorf School is not responsible to enforce or monitor compliance with domestic orders or directives, or for any party's violation of such orders or directives.

Agreement to Provide Information.

I agree to furnish all enrollment forms and contracts, proof of current immunizations, medical information, and all emergency forms required before the first day of class; and such other forms or documents as Bright Water Waldorf School may reasonably require. I agree that failure to do so may result in the interruption in my child's attendance without any reduction in fees.

Governing Law; Venue. This contract shall be governed, construed, and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington, without regard to its conflict of laws rules. I (a) consent to the exclusive jurisdiction and venue of the federal and state courts located in the state of Washington in any action arising out of or relating to this contract; (b) I waive any objection they might have to jurisdiction or venue of such forums or that the forum is inconvenient; and (c) I agree not to bring any such action in any other jurisdiction or venue to which I might be entitled by domicile or otherwise.

I understand and agree to all the terms of Bright Water Waldorf School's Summer Camp Enrollment Contract. This contract must be signed by ALL parties responsible for the fulfillment of this agreement.
